It was developed to simplify task organization and reduce the complexity of project management. Features: Integration with many other services, such as Google Drive, allows users to add documents directly to tasks.

2. Asana — a flexible platform that enables teams to organize and track work in real time. It was created to improve team collaboration and task management. Features: Customizable dashboards for different projects, allowing visualization of progress and deadlines.

3. Monday — a universal platform that provides the ability to customize workflows according to the team's needs. It is oriented towards large businesses and teams working on multiple projects simultaneously. Features: Built-in templates that simplify workflow setup for new projects.

4. ClickUp — a powerful integrated solution that offers various functions for optimizing workflows. This platform provides tools for task management, time tracking, and collaboration. Features: The ability to create customizable dashboards and automatic reminders, helping to avoid missed deadlines.

In addition to the programs reviewed, it is worth mentioning other popular solutions. For example, Basecamp has a simple interface for team collaboration and

task tracking. Notion combines note-taking and database functions, allowing users to customize their workspace to meet their needs. Wrike focuses on large-scale projects and provides powerful analytical capabilities for visualizing progress.

So, what is the use of these programs in large design projects? Many well-known design projects around the world utilize these platforms for task management. For example:

- Trello is widely used in projects by small design studios, such as Fjord, to organize work stages and track progress.
- Asana has been applied in large-scale projects by companies like Airbnb, where integration between teams is crucial.
- Monday is used for managing large design campaigns at L'Oréal, ensuring transparency in workflows at all stages.
- ClickUp is widely used in large creative agencies, such as Frog Design, for organizing workflows and managing tasks in UX/UI design projects.

Optimization of task and deadline management processes is a crucial element of successfully completing design projects. The choice of a specific project management tool depends on the type of project and the number of team members. Trello is suitable for small projects with fewer tasks and participants due to its simplicity and intuitive interface. Asana offers flexible process management and is ideal for medium and large projects where collaboration between multiple teams is important. Monday is becoming an essential tool for enterprise teams managing large numbers of simultaneous campaigns, while ClickUp is chosen by those who require integration and automation in their workflows.

Therefore, the choice of a project management tool should be based on the specific needs of the team and the complexity of the project. All applications presented in this study are useful in their own way and contribute to the optimization of modern management of any organization, including various creative fields.
