At the beginning of the 20th century in Paris, once in a while "trendsetter in Europe, began to show samples of new clothing, and soon spread to other countries. Fashion, in this time period (mostly "Haute Couture") focused exclusively on individuals.[2]

By the mid-20th century fashion was mass-produced. In all likelihood, this period of time should be considered a prototype of the current fashion industry. Range and quantity of manufactured products increased significantly, making the choice of clothing and the extent of its availability much closer to a greater number of people.

Towards the end of the 20th century, thanks to specialized publications, television and numerous courses, awareness people in the field of fashion design
increased. As a result, a significant portion of buyers when selecting goods start to rely on their own understanding of convenience, comfort and aesthetics more than on current trends in the industry.[2]

Today, the profession of fashion clothing designer is considered to be prestigious. Currently a growing number of students who study and work in the fashion industry are observed. Different educational institutions across the globe offer courses and internships designed to enhance skills in fashion design.

Achievements in the field of fashion design, contribute to the development of related professions, such as: hairdresser, make-up artist, journalist and consultant in the field of fashion, fashion clothes photographer, etc.
